

ABOUT ANTALYA

Antalya, located on the stunning Mediterranean coast of Türkiye, is a vibrant city known as the "Turkish Riviera." It is celebrated for its beautiful beaches, crystal-clear waters, and a perfect blend of historical charm and modern attractions. The city welcomes millions of visitors annually with its warm climate, lively atmosphere, and unique cultural heritage.

It is typical of Türkiye, a thriving modern city, with a historic heart in the center of Kaleiçi within the old city walls. This area has seen something of a renaissance in recent years, with many of the wooden Ottoman mansions being restored and turned into boutique hotels. No cars are allowed in the narrow streets of the old town so it is a good place to soak up the atmosphere around the charming harbour. The symbol of Antalya is the fluted minaret or Yivli Minare built by the Seljuks in the 13th century. There are plenty of interesting pieces in the Archaeological Museum, from the Palaeolithic Age right through to Ottoman times.

Kaleiçi (Old Town)


Step back in time as you wander through the charming streets of Kaleiçi, the historic heart of Antalya. This picturesque area is filled with Ottoman-era houses, boutique shops, and cozy cafés. The marina offers stunning sea views, and you'll find landmarks like the Clock Tower and the Yivli Minaret, an iconic symbol of the city.



Düden Waterfalls

Düden Waterfalls is a stunning natural attraction in Antalya, Turkey. The waterfalls are split into two parts: Upper Düden, surrounded by lush greenery, and Lower Düden, which cascades dramatically into the Mediterranean Sea. It's a perfect spot for nature lovers and photography enthusiasts.

HISTORICAL LANDMARKS AND MOST POPULAR MUSEUMS IN ANTALYA REGION



The Museum of Antalya

Founded in 1922 by Süleyman Fikri Erten, the Antalya Museum was initially housed in the Alaaddin Mosque and later the Yivli Minaret before moving to its current location in 1972. The museum is one of Turkey's most important, showcasing artifacts from the Hellenistic, Roman, Byzantine, and Turkish periods. It consists of 12 display halls, gardens, and open galleries, presenting the history of Antalya from prehistoric times to the modern era. The museum also features a "Children's Museum" designed to engage kids and provide a nursery for them while parents explore the exhibits.



Hadrian's Gate

Built in 130 AD to honor Emperor Hadrian's visit, this grand Roman archway is the best-preserved ancient structure in Antalya. Its marble columns and intricate carvings make it a striking entrance to the historic Kaleiçi.



Perge Ancient City

Perge is one of the most popular historical sites in the Antalya region, known for its ancient Greek and Roman ruins dating back to 1300 BC. The site includes a grand amphitheater that once held 15,000 spectators and is located near the city center. Perge was an important city during the Roman and Hittite periods, flourishing in the 2nd and 3rd centuries AD. It was famous for its architecture and sculpture, and many artifacts from Perge are displayed at the Antalya Museum.



Aspendos Theater

Just 50 km east of Antalya, Aspendos was an important centre of trade during Roman times. Today, the most impressive aspect of Aspendos is her stunning theatre, which was built in approx. 162 AD. It seats 15,000 and has been beautifully preserved. Each year it hosts the Aspendos Opera and Ballet Festival which takes place in June and July and gives you the opportunity to see performances of classics in a magnificent setting. The aqueduct, which supplied water to the city is also still relatively intact and is an impressive sight.
